

How to use this Product

This project is designed as a group project to complete in the last 1/3 of the book.

As a group project:

- ❑ Activity Duration: 120 minutes
- ❑ Groups are suggested to be at least 5 people (1 person for each theme.)
- ❑ Students should spend the first 30-45 minutes discussing theme and how they want their poster to connect, look, figure out who is responsible for what, etc.
- ❑ Posters can be as big as students want them to be. My students made their portion of the project on 8.5" x 11" paper, and then everyone glued and stapled their posters together to make a giant mind map.
